Dear Parent/Guardian,

I'm delighted to let you know that we have launched our recruitment for the Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) for this academic year. The Gold Award is open to all Year 12 as of 01 September 2024.

Why do DofE?

Doing DofE is a brilliant way for your young person to discover just how much they are capable of. It gives young people the chance to make new friends, follow their passions, learn new skills and make a difference in our community. Gaining a DofE Award is a great way to impress employers too.

How it works

Our students can enter the Gold Award as a direct entrant without having undertaken a Silver Award. This also applies to those of our students still currently completing their Silver Award.

Current participants can register for Gold and once their Silver is approved the edofe system will automatically update to the new reduced timescales. Once one of their sections on the Silver Award is complete for example volunteering, they can proceed straight away with that section on their Gold Award. So, both awards can be open simultaneously making it more achievable for those who have struggled with certain sections coming out of the covid pandemic.

Expedition

Here at Pate's, we run our expeditions based on the open expedition model. Inclusivity is an essential part of the school and DofE ethos and we have implemented this change so that each student can choose the dates that suits them without the stress of finding a group. We hope that this will also encourage them to make new friends and build confidence in working with new people.

It is important to note that it is not mandatory for our students to complete their expedition with us. So, if they cannot make any of our advertised dates then they can use an outside activity provider, details can be found on the dofe website. www.dofe.org

Please note whilst attending training there will be no exceptions made for you to attend sports/other commitments at the same time so, please check your diaries and with the PE staff to ensure there is no conflict between events.

There is the option for students to canoe or walk for their gold expedition. However, we are only able to offer 24 spaces for canoeing due to the restrictions on equipment. An application form will be available on our website from 9am on the 21 September to apply for either a canoeing or walking expedition.

All students must complete 1 each of the following: For those of you who are direct entrants (i.e. you have not undertaken either a bronze or silver expedition) or you want to complete your expedition using a different method of travel from your previous award (i.e. you want to complete a canoeing expedition at Gold, after completing a walking expedition at Silver), then it is a mandatory requirement that you attend the travel specific core skills training.
